

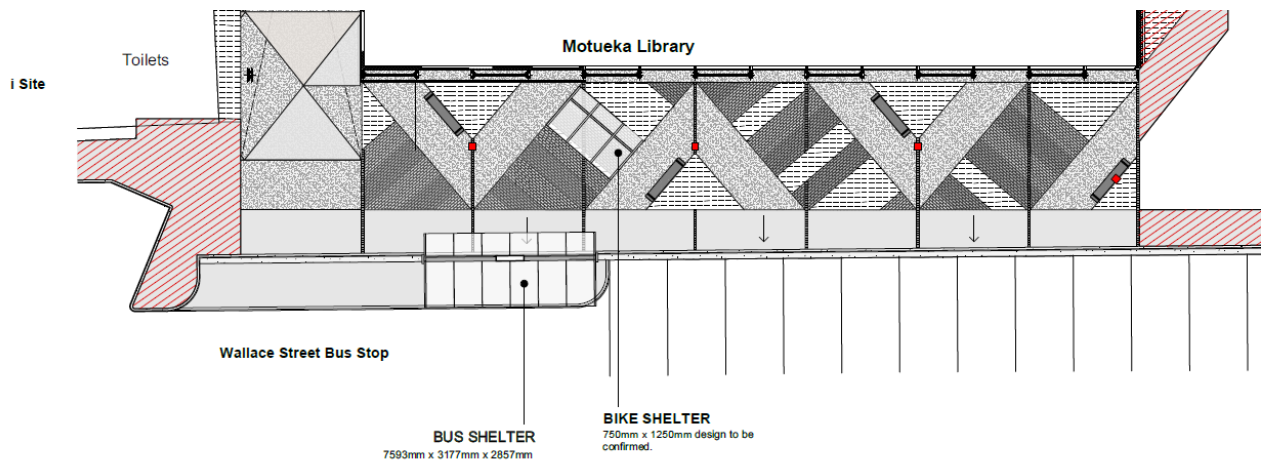
Proposal for a bus shelter and bike shelter to be installed on Wallace Street. Adjacent to the bus stop, located outside the Motueka Library.

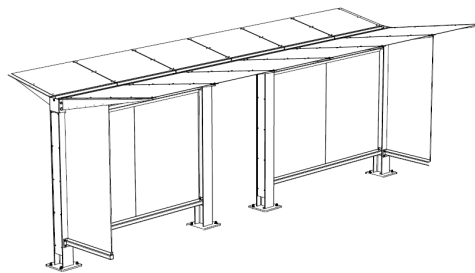
Kia ora,

Tasman District Council is working on a Waka Kotahi (NZ Transport agency) funded Transport Choices project, to make safety improvements for bus users, pedestrians and cyclists in Motueka, this includes a bus and bike shelter located on Wallace Street.

A draft plan for Wallace Street outside the Library is shown below.



The bus shelter design is indicative only and subject to change.



What are the types of things we have considered in these designs?

- The bus stop location outside the Motueka Library.
- Accessibility of the shelters for library and bus users.
- The visual impact of the bus and bike shelters on users of the library and surrounding properties.
- The extent and cost of the proposed work.

Why are we letting you know?

It is important that those directly affected by the proposed changes have a chance to provide feedback on these plans. This consultation aligns with the Local Government Act 2002.
